Eli¹ Bland (596)^{1,2} married Sarah Anderson (597).³ He died in 1826 at New Orleans, Louisiana.⁴ He was listed on the tax rolls in 1830 at Monroe County, Kentucky.⁵

1 Colin² Bland (5783) was admitted to bar on 8 Oct 1845 at Platte County, Missouri.⁶

2 Elizabeth Ann² Bland (534) was born on 25 Dec 1813.⁷ ⁸ She married Henry F. Burke (533) on 22 Oct 1835 at Monroe County, Kentucky.^{9,10} She was listed on the tax rolls with 1 slave valued at \$400, 3 horses, 8 cows and 1 C&W in 1847 at Platte County, Missouri.^{11,12} She sold negro slave Clara for \$759 leaving balance of \$214.27 owed on estate of Henry F. Burke before 1 Feb 1847 at Platte County, Missouri.¹³ She sold land being lots no. 11 and 12 in block 42 of Weston after 1 Feb 1847 at Platte County, Missouri.¹⁴ She purchased the S 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 34 T54 R36 for \$260 from Elihu H. Randolph and his wife Marthy on 25 Mar 1847 at Platte County, Missouri.¹⁵ She was appointed administratrix by County Court for estate of Henry F. Burke, late of Platte County Missouri deceased intestate on 8 May 1847 at Platte County, Missouri.¹⁶ She was listed on the tax rolls with 1 slave valued at \$250 in 1849 at Platte County, Missouri.^{17,18} She is head of household on the census of 13 Aug 1850 at Weston, Platte County, Missouri, as Elizabeth Burk, a 35 year old female farmer born KY. Enumerated with were Angelina Jane Burke (531), Milton E. Burke (571), Sarah E. Burke (572), Pamilla A. Burke (573), and John Martin Burke (574).^{19,20,21} She purchased land being the northwest forty of the SW 1/4 Section 34 T54 R36 from Elisah H. Randolph for \$300 on 21 May 1851 at Platte County, Missouri.²² She sold land land being the 10 acres of land lying on the East side of Bear creek and adjoining the land of John Groff all part of West 1/2 sW 1/4 S34 T54 R36 to John Groff for \$100 on 7 Sep 1852 at Platte County, Missouri.²³ She sold land being the E 1/2 SW 1/4 Sectin 34 T54 R365 containing 80 acres for \$3200 to Matthew Martin Bland (592) on 21 Apr 1860 at Platte County, Missouri.²⁴ She is head of household on the census of 29 Jun 1860 at Marshall Twp., Platte County, Missouri, as Elizabeth Burk, a 46 year old female born KY. Enumerated with were Milton E. Burke (571), Sarah E. Burke (572), Pamilla A. Burke (573), and Davis Burke (643).²⁵ She may be the same individual as Mrs. Jane Burke (6783). Mrs. Jane Burke married Joseph Moor on 31 May 1866.²⁶ She died before 5 May 1876 at Platte County, Missouri.^{27,28}

21 Mary³ Burke (1549).²⁹ She married Patarich Kenney (1550) on 15 Nov 1857 at Platte County, Missouri.³⁰

22 Angelina Jane³ Burke (531) was born on 30 Oct 1836 at Kentucky.^{31,32} She appeared on the census of 1850 at Marshall Twp., Platte County, Missouri.³³ She was enumerated with Elizabeth Ann Bland (534) on the census of 13 Aug 1850 at Weston, Platte County, Missouri, listed as Angelina Burk a 13 year old female born Tenn.^{34,35,36} She married Hiram M. Currey (530), son of Hiram M. Currey (532) and Rachel Harris (1291), on 3 Aug 1856 at Weston, Platte County, Missouri.^{37,38,39} ^{40,41} She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1860 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Angelina Curry a 23 year old white female born KY.⁴² She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Angeline Curry a 31 year old white female born Kentucky.⁴³ She and Hiram M.

Currey (530) sold at a sheriff's sale NW 1/4 S26T7R21 on 15 Dec 1871 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, to Moses J. Patterson.⁴⁴ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as A. J. Curry a 39 year old female born KY.⁴⁵ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) and Guilford Hornbuckle and Sarah E. Hornbuckle, his wife filed petition on 5 May 1876 at Weston, Platte County, Missouri, against John M. Burke and Milton E. Burke seeking partition of E 1/2 SW 1/4 S34 T54 R36 in Platte County.⁴⁶ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) along with Gilford Hornbuckle and his wife Sarah petitioned John M. Burk and Milton E. Burk for partition of land being the E 1/2 SW 1/4 S34 T54 R36 in Nov 1876 at Platte County, Missouri.⁴⁷ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) along with Guilford Hornbuckle and Sarah Hornbuckle his wife were plaintiffs in a case against Milton E. Burke where the court found for the plaintiffs and assessed \$679.92 against the defendant on 5 Apr 1877 at Platte County, Missouri.⁴⁸ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) as plaintiffs along with Guilford Hornbuckle and Sarah Hornbuckle, his wife, appealed an earlier decision against John M. Burke and Milton E. Burke upheld on 10 Apr 1877 at Platte County, Missouri.⁴⁹ She purchased by Deed of sale from Owen Duffy and Catherine Duffy the S 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 S25 T9 R22 20 acres on 19 Aug 1879 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁵⁰ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Angelina Currey a 43 year old white wife keeping house.⁵¹ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Angelina Curry a 47 year old married female born MO who came to KS from MO.⁵² She and Hiram M. Currey (530) sold by Deed of sale to Leavenworth Northern and Southern Railway Co. 100 feet wide easement - 50 feet each side of railroad W 20 acres of S 40 acres of SE 1/4 S25 T9 R22E from station 808-42 to station 814-40, 1 37/100 acres on 11 Jan 1887 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁵³ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) sold by Deed of sale to W. H. Bond coal and other mineral rights on the E side SE 1/4 S25 T9 R22 1 acre; and S. side SE 1/4 S25 T9 R23 20 acres on 12 Jun 1889 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁵⁴ She and Hiram M. Currey (530) sold by Sheriff's deed to Samuel J. Sull S1/2 SE 1/4 S25 T9 R22, 20 acres as judgement against Angelina Jane Burke (531) and Hiram M. Currey (530) in suit filed by Samuel J. Sull against Angelina J. Curry, Hiram M. Curry, George W. Mickle, The Moline Plan Company and the Bastope Coal and Mining company on 10 Jul 1893 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁵⁵ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1895 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as A. J. Correy 59 year old female born Kentucky.⁵⁶ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Angelina Currey a 63 year old white female who was born 10/1836 in Kentucky who has been married 44 years.⁵⁷ She died on 26 Mar 1901 at Lansing, Leavenworth, Kansas, at age 64.^{58,59} She was buried after 26 Mar 1901 at Mt. Muncie Cemetery, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.^{60,61}

221 Sarah Evelina⁴ Curry (555). She was born on 31 Jan 1859.⁶² She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1860 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Sarah Curry a 1 year old female born Kansas.⁶³ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Eveline Curry a 11 year old white female born Kansas.⁶⁴ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, a 15 year old female born KS.⁶⁵ She married Samuel D. Morris (563) on 25 Sep 1879 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, by E. H. Foster,

minister of the gospel.^{66,67} She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Eveline Currey a 21 year old daughter born KS.⁶⁸ She died on 4 Dec 1884 at age 25.⁶⁹

222 John Henry⁴ Curry (556) was born on 11 Mar 1861.⁷⁰ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as John Curry a 8 year old white male born Kansas.⁷¹ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as J. H. Curry a 13 year old male born KS.⁷² He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as John Currey a 19 year old white son born KS.⁷³ He was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁷⁴ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as John Curry a 23 year old single male born KS.⁷⁵ He resided in 1889 at 750 Shawnee, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, working as a barber.⁷⁶ He resided between 1890 and 1893 at 748 Shawnee, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, working as a barber.⁷⁷ He married Mollie O. Rourke (5395) on 1 Dec 1890 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, by T. K. Taylor, J. P.⁷⁸ He working as a barber between 1894 and 1895 at 730 Shawnee, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁷⁹ He resided between 1895 and 1896 at 712 Shawnee, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, working as a barber.⁸⁰ He resided between 1896 and 1898 at 705 Delaware, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, working as a barber.⁸¹ He died on 14 Apr 1898 at Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, at age 37.^{82,83,84,85}

223 Mary Caroline⁴ Curry (557). She was born on 8 May 1864.⁸⁶ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Mary Curry a 6 year old white female born Kansas.⁸⁷ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as M. C. Curry an 11 year old female born KS.⁸⁸ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Mary C. Currey a 16 year old white daughter born KS.⁸⁹ She was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.⁹⁰ She married Henry J. Spears (564) on 12 Feb 1886 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, by W. A. Crawford, minister M.E. Church.^{91,92,93} She died at Leavenworth, Kansas.

224 Hiram Miles⁴ Currey (517) was born on 23 Oct 1866 at Missouri.^{94,95,96} He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Hiram Curry a 3 year old white male born Kansas.⁹⁷ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as H. M. Curry Jr a 7 year old male born Kansas.⁹⁸ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Hiram Currey a 13 year old white son born KS.⁹⁹ He was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁰⁰ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Hiram Curry a 15 year old single male born KS.¹⁰¹ He was educated between 1890 and 1891 at William Jewell College, Liberty, Clay Co., Missouri.¹⁰² He married Winnie Mae Hutchinson (518), daughter of

Albert Hutchinson (535) and Julia Harding (536), on 13 May 1891 at Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.¹⁰³ He and family visited his parents the Saturday and Sunday before 3 Jan 1896 at Lansing, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁰⁴ He is head of household on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as Hiram Carrey, a 33 year old married white male magnetic healer who was born 10/1866 in Kansas and has been married 11 years. Enumerated with were Winnie Mae Hutchinson (518), Henry Currey (520), Herbert Miles Currey (521), and Myrtle Irene Currey (523).¹⁰⁵ He resided in 1902 at Lansing, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, and was employed as a miner.¹⁰⁶ He is head of household on the census of Jul 1905 at Lansing, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as H. M. Curry, a 34 year old white male born KS who came to KS from MO. Enumerated with were Winnie Mae Hutchinson (518), Henry Currey (520), Herbert Miles Currey (521), Myrtle Irene Currey (523), Mary Lela Currey (524), and Winnie Letha Currey (177).¹⁰⁷ He and Winnie Mae Hutchinson (518) sold by warranty deed to J. M. Abeles; Lot 3, block 10 on 4 Jan 1909 at Lansing, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁰⁸ He is head of household on the census of Jul 1910 at Rooks Co., Kansas, as Hiram M. Currey, a 44 year old white male born KS. Enumerated with were Winnie Mae Hutchinson (518), Herbert Miles Currey (521), Myrtle Irene Currey (523), Mary Lela Currey (524), Winnie Letha Currey (177), and Earnest Oran Currey (525).¹⁰⁹ He resided on 2 Oct 1913 at South Chestnut, Olathe, Johnson Co., Kansas.¹¹⁰ He was enumerated with Myrtle Irene Currey (523) on the census of 19 Apr 1930 at 510 1/2 Avenue G, Dodge City, Ford County, Kansas, listed as H. Miles Curry a 63 year old male born Kansas who works as a carpenter in building construction.¹¹¹ He died from a cerebral hemorrhage and arteriosclerosis on 15 Sep 1943 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, at age 76.^{112,113,114} He was buried on 18 Sep 1943 at Maple Grove Cemetery, Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas; Lot 10, block 73, section 9.^{115,116,117} Gravestone for him was purchased by she on 6 May 1946.¹¹⁸

225 William Quincy⁴ Curry (558) was born on 11 Dec 1868 at Kansas.¹¹⁹ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of 20 Jul 1870 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Quincy Curry a 1 year old white male born Kansas.¹²⁰ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as W. Q. Curry a 5 year old male born KS.¹²¹ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as William Curry A 9 year old white son born KS.¹²² He was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹²³ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as William Curry a 17 year old single male born KS.¹²⁴ He married Jessie A. Myers (566) on 20 Oct 1891 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas; by E. Atkinson, minister of gospel.¹²⁵ He was an engineer Rush Milling Co while living at at 316 S. 10th, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, in 1896.¹²⁶ He was an engineer while living at at 229 9th Ave., Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, between 1899 and 1900.¹²⁷ He is head of household on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as William Curry, a 31 year old married white male teamster born 12/1868 in Kansas who has been married 8 years. Enumerated with were Jessie A. Myers (566), Edna Curry (567), Grace L. Curry (568), Frank W. Curry (569), and Florence Curry (570).^{128,129} He filed for divorce from Jessie A. Myers (566) on 20 Nov 1902 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, and sought custody of

children William Quincy Curry (558), Edna Curry (567), Grace L. Curry (568), Frank W. Curry (569), and Florence Curry (570).¹³⁰ He resided on 4 May 1910 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹³¹ He is head of household on the census of Jul 1910 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as William Curry, a 41 year old white male born KS. Enumerated with were Jessie A. Myers (566), Edna Curry (567), Grace L. Curry (568), Frank W. Curry (569), Florence Curry (570), and Esther H. Curry (661).¹³² He married Laura (--?--) (5368) after 1911.¹³³ He is head of household on the census of Jul 1920 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as William Curry, a 52 year old white male engineer and bridge builder born in KS. Enumerated with were Laura (--?--) (5368), Edna Curry (567), Esther H. Curry (661), and Opal I Curry (5369).¹³⁴ He died in 1952 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹³⁵ He was buried in 1952 at Mt. Muncie Cemetery, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹³⁶

226 James Gilbert⁴ Curry (559) was born on 10 Oct 1871 at Kansas.¹³⁷ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as J. G. Curry a 3 year old male born KS.¹³⁸ He was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹³⁹ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as James Curry a 11 year old single male born KS.¹⁴⁰ He married Mannie Ridge (584) on 29 Nov 1895 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas; by T. J. McCaull, Fort Leavenworth.^{141,142} He died at Norton, Norton, Kansas. He is head of household on the census of 2 Jun 1900 at Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as James Gilbert Curry, a 28 year old whitemale railroad conductor who was born Oct 1871 in Kansas. Enumerated with were Mannie Ridge (584).¹⁴³ He is head of household on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, as James G. Curry, a 28 year old white male born 10/1871 in Leavenworth Co. KS. Enumerated with were Mannie Ridge (584).¹⁴⁴ He and Mannie Ridge (584) were defendants in a suit filed by The Minneapolis Threshing Machine Co on 23 Nov 1904 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁴⁵

227 Elizabeth Jane⁴ Curry (560). She was born on 22 May 1874 at Kansas.^{146,147} She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1875 at Kickapoo Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Lizzie Curry a 1 year old female born KS.¹⁴⁸ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Lizzia Currey a 5 year old white daughter bornKS.¹⁴⁹ She was educated on 7 May 1881 at Nine Mile School, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁵⁰ She married Robert Rigsby (565) before 1884.¹⁵¹ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Elizabeth Curry a 9 year old single female born KS.¹⁵² She was enumerated with Robert Rigsby (565) on the census of 1 Jun 1900 at 711 39th St., Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, listed as Lizzie Rigsby a 26 year old female born May 1874 in KS who is the wife of head of household.¹⁵³ She died at Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.

228 Dora Ann⁴ Curry (561).¹⁵⁴ She was born on 14 Oct 1876 at Lansing, Leavenworth, Kansas.^{155,156,157} She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1880 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Dora Currey a 3 year old white daughter born KS.¹⁵⁸ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the

census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Dora Curry a 7 year old single female born KS.¹⁵⁹ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1895 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Dora Correy 18 year old female born KS.¹⁶⁰ She was visiting in Kansas City on 7 Jan 1897.¹⁶¹ She was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Dora A. Currey a 17 year old single white female born 5/1883 in Kansas.¹⁶² She married Charles Lee Marts (6784), son of Samuel Marts (6838) and Martha Ellen Mauck (6839), on 25 Apr 1901.¹⁶³ On 5 Mar 1961, Dora Ann Curry (561) of Long Beach, California, wrote her niece and nephew (Winnie Crawford) to offer condolences.¹⁶⁴ She died on 29 Apr 1968 at Long Beach, Los Angeles County, California, at age 91.^{165,166}

229 Marion Franklin⁴ Curry (562) was born on 12 Apr 1881 at Kansas.¹⁶⁷ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1885 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Marion Curry a 4 year old single male born KS.¹⁶⁸ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jul 1895 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Marrian Correy a 14 year old male born KS.¹⁶⁹ He was enumerated with Hiram M. Currey (530) on the census of Jun 1900 at Delaware Twp., Leavenworth Co., Kansas, listed as Marion H. Currey a 18 year old single white male born 3/1882 in Kansas.¹⁷⁰ He died on 7 Jul 1903 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas, at age 22.¹⁷¹ He was buried after 7 Jul 1903 at Mount Muncie Cemetery, Leavenworth County, Kansas.¹⁷²

22A Frank⁴ Currey (5396)^{173,174,175} was born on 2 Nov 1884 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁷⁶ He died on 14 Feb 1885 at Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁷⁷ He was buried after 14 Feb 1885 at Mt. Muncie Cemetery, Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.¹⁷⁸
